What:

We are looking for participants for a **study on visual perception**. The study involves a discrimination task on a **computer screen**. While you perform the task, we record eye movements, accuracy and reaction time of your responses. Thereby, we want to find out how sensory features like shape, motion, and color are integrated into a unified perception.

Who:

You can participate if you want to support scientific research and earn a small amount of extra money. We are looking for people who:

- Are between **20 and 35 years old**
- Have **normal or corrected sight** (glasses, contact lenses, etc.)
- Have no history of **neurological** or **current mental disorders** (Migraine, Epilepsy)
- Are available for **two different sessions** on different days

Payment:

Participants will receive a compensation of **8 Euros per hour**.

Where & When:

The study takes place at the **German Primate Center** (Hans-Adolf-Krebs-Weg 7, 37077 Göttingen). Appointments for the session will be scheduled via email. Each session lasts approximately **1.5 to 2 hours**.
