- » Content creation: produce engaging content for press materials, newsletters, websites, blogs, and social media in collaboration with PR offices of the University, University Hospital and CECAD partners
- » Management and monitoring of social media and digital presence
- » Support CECAD Office in internal communication initiatives
- » Represent CECAD in the division 8 of the University
