## **YOUR TASKS**

The professorship contributes in particular to teaching in the Master's programme Intercultural Communication and Education and its organisation and profile-building. Collaboration in further development of the Mercator Institute would be desirable. Participation in the academic self-administration is obligatory.

## YOUR PROFILE

Applicants have a profound expertise in the field of educational migration research, in a transnational comparative perspective, with a focus on at least two of the following research fields:

- Education and pedagogy in migration societies
- Multilingualism
- Transnational mobility
- critique of racism in the field of education

The focal points must be substantiated by outstanding research, third-party fund research and corresponding publications in national and international journals or peer-reviewed journals. Participation in the research activities of the department and the faculty, including the implementation of externally funded research projects, is expected.

## **OUR OFFER**

The University of Cologne provides a stimulating academic environment with a wide range of career development opportunities as well as support services for dual career couples and family-friendly working conditions.

The position is available at the earliest possible date. Formal requirements are detailed in Section 36 of the Higher Education Act of North Rhine-Westphalia (Hochschulgesetz – HG NRW). As a rule, the teaching load comprises nine semester hours per week (i.e., two hours per week is one 90-minute course per semester).
