# Professorship in Philosophy and History of Medieval Philosophy (W3) (f/m/x)

Applicants should therefore be able to lead all the specific research activities pursued at the Thomas-Institut (critical editions, conferences, international research projects, etc.) and have the relevant experience.

We are seeking an outstanding academic in the field of Medieval Philosophy and, in particular, Latin Medieval Philosophy who possesses expertise in critical editions and management experience. The successful candidate will be committed to continue developing a research institute of international standing, taking into account the interdisciplinary contexts at the Faculty of Arts and Humanities. Part of that is the successful acquisition and implementation of third-party-funded projects. We also expect you to contribute teaching, beyond your particular research field, in all the degree programmes of the subject group. You should be prepared to participate in joint research activities of the Faculty and in academic self-administration.
