The CFR Junior Professorship for Investments has a vacancy for a research assistant (f/m/x) with the desire to pursue a doctoral degree in Finance. The position is initially limited for two years but with the intention of a two-year extension.

- » Research, including participation in and independent advancement of empirical research projects in the areas of asset pricing, monetary policy, and market microstructure.
- Teaching, including independent teaching of seminars for the Faculty of Management, Economics and Social Sciences.
- » The opportunity for academic qualification (doctorate) in the above mentioned finance areas is given and expected.

- » Strong interest in empirical research; knowledge of quantitative empirical methods and data analysis (e.g., Matlab) is highly desirable. Knowledge of text recognition programmes would be a plus.
- » Knowledge of common finance databases (e.g., WRDS Morningstar) would be a plus.
- » Very good written and spoken English skills.
